Local Law No. 1 of the year 1979

Open Containers

A local law (Insert title)

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the (Name of Legislative Body)

County of Russell as follows:

Open Containers

- No person shall have in his possession any open bottle or container containing or which previously contained any alcoholic beverage while such person is on any public highway, street, sidewalk, parking area, or any other public place or in any motor vehicle upon any public place within a one-half mile radius of the intersection of East Road, Bridge Street, Pestle Street, and School Road in the Hamlet of Russell, Town of Russell, New York, except the athletic field fenced-in area and any premises duly licensed for the sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages on the premises.
- Such an open bottle or open container in any motor vehicle shall be presumptive evidence that the same is in the possession of all occupants thereof and in violation hereof.
- A violation of this section shall constitute an offense punishable by a fine not exceeding twenty-five dollars (\$25.) or by imprisonment for ten (10) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment for the first offense, and by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50.) or by imprisonment for thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment for a second or subsequent offense.
