

SECTION 1. Change in Term of Office. The term of office of the Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Russell shall be changed to a four (4) year term commencing with the term of the Town Superintendent of Highways elected at the next biennial Town election held after the effective date of this local law.

SECTION 2. When Effective. This local law shall be subject to a mandatory referendum pursuant to Section 23 of the Municipal Home Rule Law and shall take effect upon approval by the electors of the Town of Russell at the general election to be held on November 8, 1994, and upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State.


