Be it enacted by the Town Board of the

- §1. The Town of Russell hereby elects to provide all of its eligible employees with a retirement incentive program authorized by Chapter 47, laws of 1998.
- §2. The commencement date of the retirement incentive program shall be September 1, 1998.
- §3. The open period during which eligible employees may retire and receive the additional retirement benefit, shall be 90 days in length.
- §4. The actuarial present value of the additional retirement benefits payable pursuant to the provisions of this local law shall be paid as one lump sum, or in five annual installments. The amount of the annual payment shall be determined by the Actuary of the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System, and shall be paid by the Town of Russell for each employee who receives the retirement benefits payable under this local law.
- §5. This act shall take effect on September 1, 1998.

Such local law was subject to permissive referendum and no valid petition requesting such referendum was filed as of 19, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

\* Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis or, if there be none, the chairperson of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village, or the supervisor of a town where such officer is vested with the power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.

5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. 1 of 1998 of the City of Town of Russell having been submitted to referendum pursuant to the provisions of section (36)(37) of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of such city voting thereon at the (special)(general) election held on AUGUST 19 1998, became operative.

6. (County local law concerning adoption of Charter.)

I hereby certify that the local law annexed hereto, designated as local law No. of 19 of the County of State of New York, having been submitted to the electors at the General Election of November 19, pursuant to subdivisions 5 and 7 of section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.
